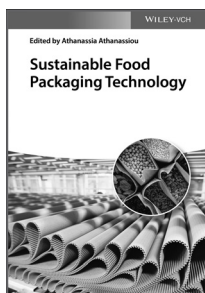
Physical-chemical Properties of Foods
