Charles Taliaferro holds the Oscar and Gertrude Boe Distinguished Chair and is Professor of Philosophy at St. Olaf College. He is the Editor-in-Chief of Open Theology, and is on the editorial board of Philosophy Compass, Sophia, and Religious Studies Review.
